

A collaborative approach that brings trusted community leaders together to coordinate state-wide voting rights activities community by community.




Georgia Team Unity

- Team Unity focuses on coming together to ensure that every person is educated and informed of the power of the vote to directly improve their lives.

Why It Works

- Team unity is an intentional focus on developing a common strategy while coordinating a variety of tactics to achieve voter participation in underserved communities.
- The Team Unity Approach increases operational efficiency and effectiveness and allows for much better deployment of financial and technological resources.
- The foundational leadership for building a team unity strategy in each state is already present. The objective is to provide strategic leadership and digital operational support to accelerate the success of their activities.
- Many states suffer from "digital sharecropping" when they don't own/operate the digital tools and resources; they are at the mercy of groups that don't share or prioritize their needs and goals.

Update Supporters

Stay connected with your supporters by posting simple messages, news updates, reminders, or even a thank you note.



Supporter Forms

Gather more info from your supporters: how they'd like to volunteer, where to place a yard sign, ask for endorsements/quotes, or any other question.



Survey Friends

Enable supporters to gather information from their friends via email, text.



Email, Text or Share with Friends

Ask your supporters to reach out to their friends via email, text or any app. Limit sharing to a target universe or let supporters reach out to anyone in their address book.



Link to Webpage

Share a link to a webpage with your supporters. Direct traffic to your website, an event, parking directions, a google map, or even a virtual phone bank.



Share Facebook Post

An easy way to inform and engage your supporters while increasing your facebook traffic.



Affinity Texting

Enable supporters to text a list of assigned contacts from their personal phone number.



All-In-One Canvass BETA

Canvass volunteers, members, voters or just about anyone via text, phone, email or in person.






Alabama to get 2 Black Congressional Districts

Federal court blocks Alabama's new congressional district map, saying it's not fair to Black voters.






Biden Administration North Carolina Impact






Text VBM Info to Ellis County 65+
